#### **Progressing Repairs**

The Owner's Corporation has been working with Insite Engineering to progress repairs on the building window leaks and water ingress. Further rectification works are moving ahead with a test area scheduled and complete works pending the result of the test area. Further details will be available at the AGM.

## **Refurbishment Project**

The refurbishment project has reached completion. The COVID-19 delays were difficult for all and complicated materials delivery and worker access. Rectification works will be addressed as a separate piece of work. Despite this, we are now happy to be able to move forward with the next stage in enhancement for The Hallmark – an interior revision of the foyer appointments and installation of new furnishings to unify the design.

## **Innovation & Future Proofing**

The Owner's Corporation is broadly investigating opportunities to innovate and meet the coming needs of The Hallmark. Initial enquiries have begun in the areas of EV chargers for electric vehicles, comprehensive internet service upgrades, and exploration of the potential for environmental upgrades in utilities.
